## Background

Small Farmers in Hawaii represent 80% of state's totals (growing areas up to 10 acres). One of the main challenges for Small Farmers is to keep up to date with regulations, USDA and FSMA requirements for good agricultural practices and food safety. Food safety is a primary concern for both the farm operators and the public consuming the agriculture products. The farm operations must follow good agriculture practices and document their actions in order to meet food safety standards. The consumers frequent stores and restaurants where safe food is distributed or prepared.

HDOA provides training and certification for pesticide use. The gap occurs on the farm where pesticide use is Federally administered through several programs and detailed reporting is required.
