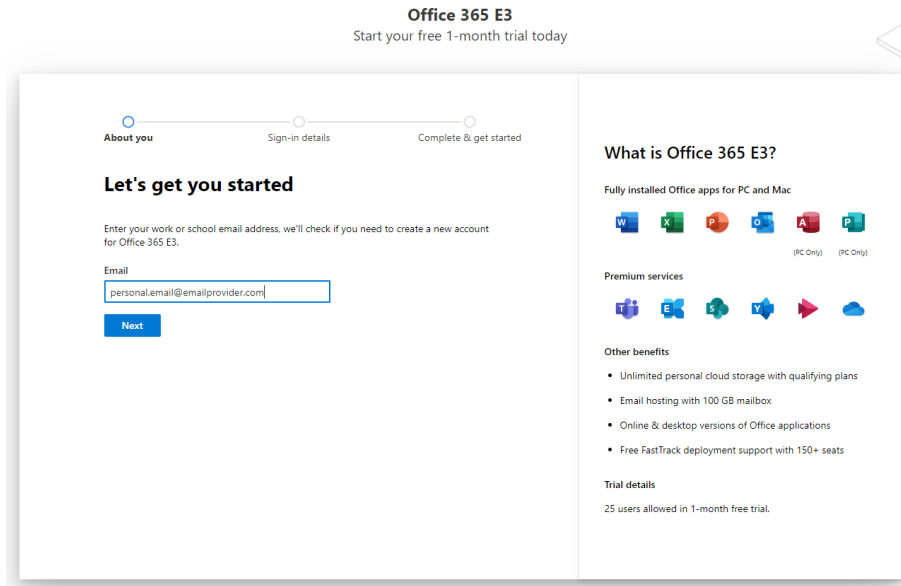

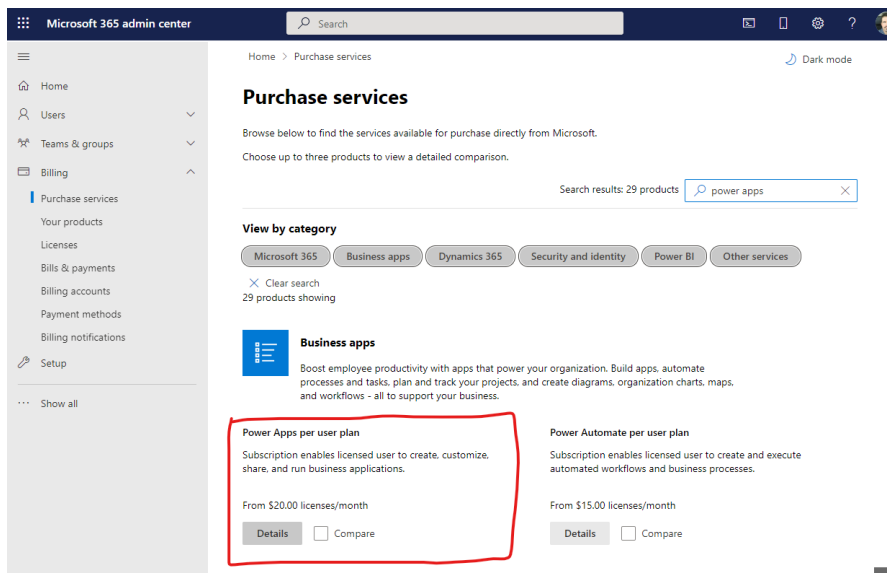
Create a trial environment with Power Platform and Office 365

DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING IN AN INPRIVATE/INCOGNITO BROWSER

1. Sign up for an Office 365 trial: [Office 365 E3 - Sign up \(microsoft.com\)](https://www.microsoft.com/office/365/trial). Use a personal email account and follow the prompts...




2. Once the sign-up process is complete, go to “Manage Subscription” (or <https://portal.office.com/adminportal>)
3. Go to Billing > Purchase Services and search for “Power Apps”
4. Select “Power Apps per user plan” -> Details



7. Select “Start Free Trial”
8. At this point you may get a message about adding a billing address. Follow the prompts to add an address.
9. After saving the billing address, a Registration section will appear. Open that section and say, I don’t have a registration number.
10. Return to Step 3 and add the Power Apps trial.

11. Once the trial is added, Go to Users > Active Users and select yourself.
12. Manage Product Licenses
13. Assign yourself a Power Apps Per User License
14. Navigate to <https://admin.powerplatform.microsoft.com>
15. Create New Environment
 - a. Assign it a name
 - b. Choose “Trial” Type for environment
 - c. Choose “Yes” for “Create a database for this environment”
 - d. Click Save; the environment will take a few minutes to prepare

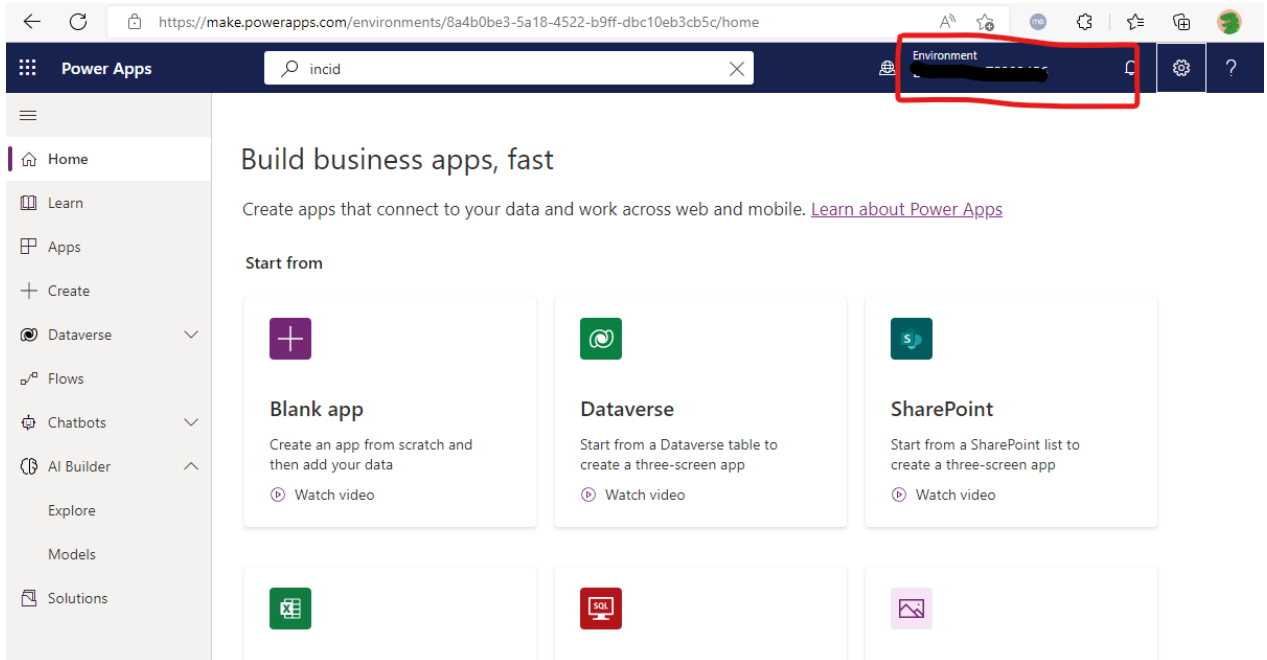

17. Select the environment you just created in the upper right-hand corner
